Elliot Leigh TLC (ELTLC) was founded in June 2016, following the success of Elliot Leigh Guaranteed Rents, which has been helping landlords, tenants and local authorities for 20 years.

Now working with more than 50 local authorities throughout London and Southeast, the ELTLC division was founded to provide semi-independent housing and support for children and young people (YP) aged 16 to 25.

We provide housing related support and house care leavers supported by the local authority and include support sessions weekly with a view to move the YP's into their forever home.

Our Mission

We implement Pathway Plans in partnership with each young individual taking their unique circumstances into consideration as and when necessary. Our comprehensive plan includes information relating to:

- Housing
- Education
- Training and Employment
- Health, including Sexual Health
- Finance
- Independent Living Skills

These plans will be reviewed and amended at regular intervals. We will ensure they are being followed and are adapted to motivate the young individual to achieve these set goals.

ELTLC also provides self-contained and semi-independent, shared supported accommodation for looked after care leavers aged 16 to 25 years, including those with children.

 - Have confidence that we understand them, and their support worker have the skills & knowledge and work effectively together to best meet their needs.
 - They have their own space and be feel proud of and live in a comfortable, well maintained, and stable accommodation.
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- They receive high-quality, tailored support that sustains their health and well-being.
 - They have strong, trusting, and meaningful relationships within us as their support system and can rely on us for their support.
 - They feel supported to learn and apply skills for independent adult living.
 - They should feel positive about their future and opportunities as a result of the support received

16 - 17 Services

The aim of our supported accommodation is to develop young people's independence in preparation for adult living while keeping them safe in a homely and nurturing environment.

18 - 25 Services

Our 18+ accommodation adapts to the growing needs of a young adult. We use a strength-based approach which looks at what skills and assets a young person has and how we can best support them.

Parent & Baby Services

We provide emotional support making sure young parents are in good mental health to have the capacity to effectively care for their children.

Asylum Seeker Services

Our mission is to offer better living condition and opportunities to the Asylum Seekers. Here, we help with everything from Housing-Related Queries to Health Registration (GP, optician, dentist), to establishing bank accounts and learning to budget and save.
